*OPPOSING THE DISCHARGE OF EFFLUENT WASTE INTO MILL CREEK AND BLUEWATER CREEK
SITES IN LAUDERDALE COUNTY*

WHEREAS, during a recent public hearing called by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management held on March 25, 2008, at Brooks High School gymnasium for the purpose of hearing public comment on a proposed sewer treatment facility to be located in East Lauderdale County, numerous concerns were raised relative to the effluent discharge into Mill Creek and Bluewater Creek; and

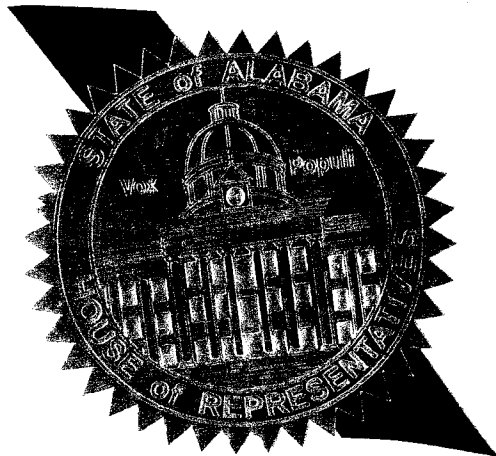
WHEREAS, a hydrogeologic assessment, prepared by an Alabama licensed professional hydrogeologist, revealed public health, environmental, and other concerns related to the proposed discharge of sewage treatment plant effluent into Mill Creek and Bluewater Creek; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that the health and safety of the citizens of this area are protected; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we express opposition to the discharge of effluent waste into the Mill Creek and Bluewater Creek sites.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution is not to be interpreted as opposition to the Town of Killen, Alabama, having a sewer system.
